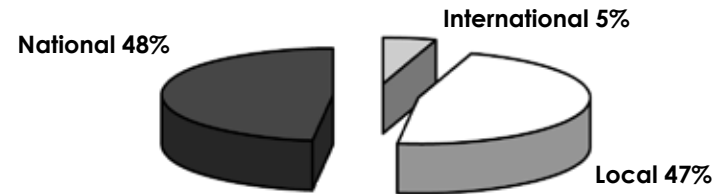

To assist with the organization of efficient teams in the Gateway CFC region, it is divided into four divisions:

Garrison: Civilian Executive branch agencies, Judicial agencies and Congressional offices

Eagle: U.S. Postal Service

Patriot: Department of Veteran's Affairs and Department of Defense (except for those at Scott Air Force Base)

Vanguard: Department of Defense and all associate units on Scott Air Force Base
